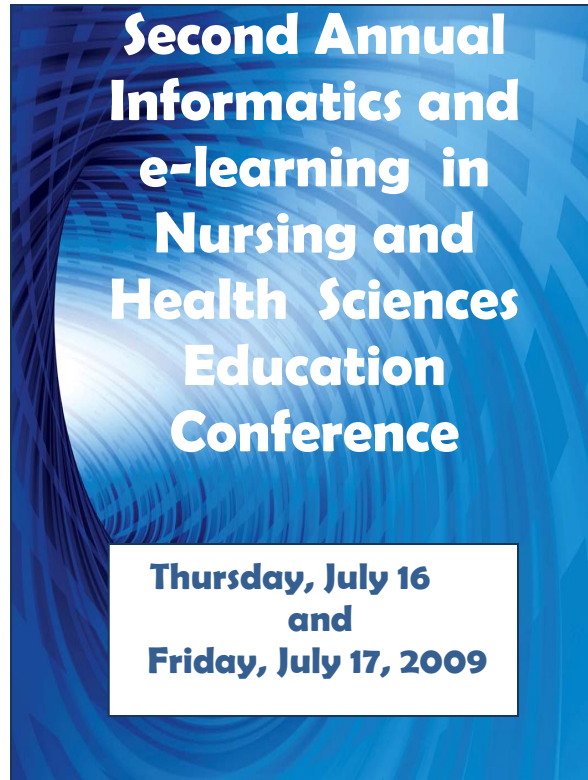

Jacqueline Moss, Ph.D., R.N.
University of Alabama at Birmingham



Dr. Moss is Assistant Dean for Clinical Simulation and Technology at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. She has conducted research designed to evaluate the structure of electronic documentation and standardized terminologies creating tools to determine work processes and information needs of practitioners in acute care. She is a two-time (2007, 2008) recipient of the Harriet H. Werley Award for nursing informatics research from the American Medical Informatics Association.
